Pentecost Sunday

This weekend, the Church celebrates Pentecost, one of the most important feast days of the year that concludes the Easter season and celebrates the beginning of the Church.

Pentecost always occurs 50 days after the death and resurrection of Jesus, and ten days after His ascension into heaven.

The timing of these feasts is also where Catholics get the concept of the Novena – nine days of prayer – because in Acts 1, Mary and the Apostles prayed together “continuously” for nine days after the Ascension leading up to Pentecost. Traditionally, the Church prays the Novena to the Holy Spirit in the days before Pentecost.

Congratulations to our Pastor Father Mark Kaminski on his 25 Year Priestly Anniversary!

Father Kaminski was born in Glogow, a city of about 74,000 near Poland's western border, and grew up in Bonn, the capital of Germany until reunification in 1990. He originally entered medical school but, after one semester, chose to enter the seminary. In 1996 he moved to Detroit to study at Ss. Cyril and Methodius Seminary, was ordained in 2001, and completed a degree in theological literature at the University of Cologne two years later. In 2008 he earned a second doctorate—this time in pastoral theology—from Catholic University in Washington, D.C. His thesis, Canonical and Administrative Foundations of Parish Leadership, proposed a model now used to train deacons for parish leadership.

After ordination, Father Kaminski came to the Diocese of Syracuse, where he served as parochial vicar, administrator, and director of the Formation for Ministry Program. He later became Pastor of St. Anthony of Padua Church, St. Mary's School, and St. Mary Church in Cortland, while also serving as chaplain at SUNY Cortland. He was then assigned Pastor of St. Anthony/St. Agnes Church in Utica and continued as Director of Formation for the Permanent Deacons.

In 2023 he was appointed Pastor of Church of the Sacred Heart/St. Mary, Our Lady of Czestochowa in New York Mills, while remaining Director of Formation for the Permanent Deacons. In 2025, following the retirement of Canon Father John Mikalajunas, he became Pastor of Holy Trinity Church.

Sto Lat, Father Mark! May God bless you for your many accomplishments and the years of service still ahead.
