Anniversary of the statue of Mary at Holy Trinity

This year, our statue of the Blessed Mother (between the convent and school parking lot) is 100 years old! The wording (paraphrased below) on the plaques is still attached to the statue and remind us of the early years of Holy Trinity and our ancestors who gave us our beautiful Church:

AD 1926

"The children of Holy Trinity Church have erected this statue to mark the site of the small wooden house where since the year 1896 the early Polish settlers have gathered for the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass."

"In memory for future generations of the Year of the Lord. 1926. Polish children with their generosity through their cooperation of the teacher sisters and the efforts of the local parish priest, Father Michał Josef Działuk erected this statue to commemorate the fact that, starting in 1896, the first few Polish settlers in Utica and the surrounding area gathered for Holy Mass in a modest wooden house on this very site; this place is the cradle of several Polish Catholic parishes.

"Ku pamięci przyszłych pokoleń Roku pańskiego. 1926. Dzieci polskie ofiarnością swoją współpraca siostr nauczycielek i staraniem miejscowego proboszcza. Is. Michała Josefa działuka wzniosły tę statuetkę na pamiątkę że na tym miejscu już od Roku 1896 skupiali się na msze świętej w skromnym drewnianym domu pierwsi nieliczni osadnicy polscy w Utica i okolice miejsce to jest kolebka kilku polskich parafii katolickich."

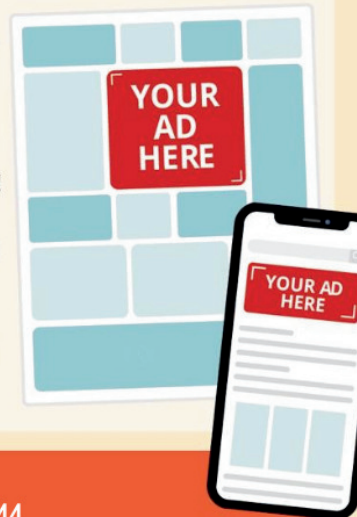
